
Step by step installation instructions



1. To install develop presets, you have to drag and drop the unzipped folder you just downloaded, into your Develop Presets folder on your system. To find this, open up Lightroom, and then click on **Lightroom>Preferences**


(If you're on a PC, I'm sorry.)






2. Click on the **“Presets”** tab and then...

3. Click on the **“Show Lightroom Presets Folder”** button, which should open that folder up in Finder




4. Click on **“Lightroom”**





5. Click on **“Develop Presets”**



6. Here's the tricky part. Drag and drop the unzipped presets folder that you opened up this fantastic readme file from, into the **“Develop Presets”** folder that you should have open. Close Lightroom, and reopen it and you should see your flashy new presets in the Develop Module of Lightroom.
